TITLE: Predicting Popcorn

SUBJECT: Math

GRADE LEVEL: 1-3

MATERIAL(S): Paper, popped popcorn, bowl

OBJECTIVE(S): To estimate how much popcorn will fit into various shapes

OVERVIEW:

1. Give students a sheet of paper with different shapes and sizes on it.
2. Give each student 1 kernel of popped popcorn to use to estimate how many pieces it would take to fill the different shapes.
3. Give them 3 cups of popped popcorn each and have them put it on the shapes.
4. Students can record their results and find out how close they were.
